### What are the WEEE and RoHS directives?

The RoHS and WEEE directives from the European community are attempting to reduce pollution and the waste of world resources. These directives currently regulate the way electrical and electronic goods are designed, manufactured and disposed of at the end of their useful life.

The RoHS (Restriction of Hazardous Substances. RoHS Directive 2002/95/EC) regulation bans any new electrical and electronic equipment containing more than agreed levels of a number of substances being placed on the EU market.

The WEEE directive deals with the disposal of Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment at the end of its useful life.
